

RE: Songwriter's Insider


Thank you for your interest in "Songwriter's Insider." It's basically a program where we let you, a songwriter, know about real-world projects that we've been commissioned to write songs for. As new opportunities arise, we will send out the specific information about the project. You can then choose to submit songs. We will collect the new songs and previously written songs from the Music Precedent (MP) catalog to pass on to the client. They will choose the song(s) they want to use. There are several considerations for participation, however.

- (1) The due dates are firm. Most of the time, We are given only 4 to 6 weeks notice from the client, so there is little if any flex available in the due dates.
- (2) It will be assumed that when you submit a song, you are agreeing to allow MP to publish it. At our discretion, should the song be chosen for the project or for inclusion in the MP catalog, you will be sent a standard songwriter's agreement to sign.
- (3) Some of the songs are royalty bearing and some may be a flat-fee. It will be noted in the packet so you'll know in advance.
- (4) Priority consideration is given to published MP writers because they have proven their level of development in the songwriting craft. Other "unpublished" writers who have expressed interest will be included as well.
- (5) It must be understood that there is a "minimum" standard of quality which a song must pass before being submitted to the client. All songs are not guaranteed to go to the next level. However, all songs are guaranteed to be heard and fairly evaluated. We will try to give feedback for future improvement wherever possible.
- (6) While the program is free to join, we do require a \$10 nonrefundable submission fee per song you send. The fee must accompany the submission for us to consider your song(s). However, for published MP composers, the fee is waived.
